

AMC FAQ:

Question: I see on the application that there is no fee listed...are you going to charge a fee?

Answer: According to statute, the fee will be established by the rules. Until the rules are official the Board may not collect a fee. The Board is not sure when the rules will be official; it could be a number of months and we are not sure if and when we will be able to collect the initial registration fee. Fee is currently set at \$2500.00.

Question: I see the deadline is 7/29/10, how do we get registered? We have people that are out of town and are unable to obtain all the information required in the application. Will we be able to continue to operate after 7/29/10?

Answer: No. You will not be able to operate in the State of Arizona without being registered. Please submit everything you can and tell us what is missing, why it's missing, and when you will be able to supply the information to the Board, and the Board will consider issuing the registration on a temporary basis. All registrations will be posted by the registered business' name on our website, www.appraisal.state.az.us, and appraisers will not be allowed to accept orders from a company unless registered name is posted.

Remember you **must** use our fingerprint card so follow the instructions on the application about ordering the card from the Board office as well as how to make out the money order or cashier's check.

Question: Do you have a list of companies that can help me obtain the required Surety Bond?

Answer: We recommend that you contact your insurance agent. They should be able to help you get the bond or recommend an outside affiliate that can help you.
